

What happens to my MTI account when I pass away?

As part of future developments, your MTI back office will provide for you to nominate a beneficiary in the event of your passing.

For now, the following is suggested:

1. Create a “Life File” that contains all important documents your loved ones will need when you pass away. (Eg your will, policies, your birth certificate etc.)
2. In this “Life File” include a detailed letter addressed to a trusted individual or spouse that includes:
 - a. Your username and password to your MTI account.
 - b. A letter to MTI confirming that a specific person (or trust) will be the beneficiary of your position in MTI together with the BTC held in this position.
Be sure to include all the details of the individual / trust (ID number etc)
 - c. Also make sure that, if you are HODLing BTC or any other crypto assets in a wallet, that this designated person has all the passwords necessary to access this wallet. Without this information the content of this wallet will be lost forever.
